

**Part 1:****➤ Jurisdictions**

The NATF organization may actively conduct fundraising programs or activities to fund the furtherance and management of our charitable activities, such as our economic or community development programs, in addition to the fundraising programs as listed in IRS 1023 Application Attachment 9. These activities may be limited to, but not restricted to, the State of Texas, in the cities of Marshall, Waxahachie, and Brownsville, in the Counties of Harrison, Ellis, and Cameron respectively.

All additional proceeds will go into the Organizations General Business Fund to provide funding for grants to individuals or organizations that are involved in activities or programs related to the National Historic Preservation Program (NHPP), the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA), and the American Battlefield Preservation Program 16 U.S.C. 469K-1 (ABPP).

These funds will also be utilized in the form of grants or other distributions to qualifying 501(c)(3) charitable children's medical treatment and research facilities and organizations, or to offer grants or other financial assistance to the families of the children sponsored by the 501(c)(3) charitable children's medical treatment facilities, as well as help fund the offering of similar programs to the Native American Tribal Communities.
